

Contributions to Support Hanging Flower Baskets



Memorial Park PARTF Project



The Blowing Rock Parks Strategy Committee submitted a park improvement needs plan to the Blowing Rock Town Council during their January retreat. Town Council encouraged the Parks Strategy Committee to pursue applying for a Parks & Recreation Trust Fund Grant (PARTF). This grant is a matching grant that the Town would match with the current approved bond money. The proposed project is to provide Memorial Park with the following upgrades and additions: an additional restroom facility, renovation of existing restrooms, ADA accessible walkway from Wallingford Lane to Memorial Park, renovation of existing tennis courts and add new pickleball courts, relocation and renovation of the existing volleyball court, addition of a new picnic area adjacent to the new playground, an additional playground feature, and the addition of shuffleboard/cornhole.

The total projected cost is \$1,285,000. The Town has approximately \$430,000 in bond money and the PARTF grant, if awarded, would be \$500,000. The \$355,000 difference would be provided by the ABC Board and TDA funds.

The Town applied for the grant at the end of April and a decision on approval will be made by September 2021.
