Annual Clean-up Week

The Town's annual clean-up week is coming up, during the week of October 3-7, 2022. During this week Town crews collect white goods, yard debris (leaves, tree branches, etc.), mattresses, etc.



Please remember the Town can no longer collect containers with liquids such as paint cans unless they contain kitty litter or oil dry. We also can not collect propane tanks, electronics, shingles, pallets or tires. These items are considered household hazardous waste and should be disposed of following guidelines available by calling Watauga County Sanitation office at (828) 264-5305. The collection site address is 336 Landfill Road in Boone.

We also ask that yard debris set out for pickup be divided by the following categories of debris: loose leaves, limbs and plants (as pictured below). Please do not block any drains, ditches or driveways.

The annual pick-up is offered once a year in the fall and there is no charge for the pick-up.



Yard debris should be separated into three piles: loose leaves, limbs, and plant debris.



Yard debris should not be placed into one pile for pickup.

Call Before You Dig!



With a number of construction and renovation projects big and small going on around Town, please remember to call before you start any projects that require digging or even grading so utility lines can be marked. North Carolina has a one call center that provides a toll-free telephone number 8-1-1, to help reduce damages to underground utilities. Taking this easy step can prevent the loss of service to the public as well as loss of time and money to homeowners and contractors during construction.

All you have to do is dial 8-1-1 and all service providers will get a single source request to come out and mark all services lines on the property making it safe to resume digging or grading.
