STATE OF THE TOWN

At the end of each fiscal year (each July) the Town has a special meeting to keep the community informed on the year's successes, current challenges, and the future for the Town of Blowing Rock.

The State of the Town was held August 15th at the Blowing Rock Art & History Museum.

Here are some highlights from the meeting:

The Blowing Rock Chamber of Commerce shared their major accomplishments throughout the year as well as a vision for sustainable and meaningful growth in Blowing Rock.

The Village Foundation of Blowing Rock gave an overview of who they are and their mission, as well as upcoming projects like the Annie Cannon Gardens and The Glen Burney Trailhead improvements.

The Tourism Development Authority of Blowing Rock (TDA) gave an overview of the financial impact visitors have on our community as well as the year's accolades and upcoming projects like new wayfinding signage.

Town Manager Shane Fox shared the Town of Blowing Rock revenue sources, a property tax comparison to local areas, Town expenditures by function, Town department breakdowns, the Blowing Rock Academy update as well as highlighted upcoming capital projects and projects in progress.

Annual Water Line Flushing November 4th-8th

Please note that the annual water line flushing is scheduled for **November 4th-8th**. This important preventive maintenance routine helps ensure you have sustained levels of high water quality by removing sediment and deposits from the more stagnant areas of the system. Some customers may briefly experience a temporary slight discoloration of water in the immediate vicinity of the flushing activity. If this happens, please run your faucets on cold for 10-15 minutes to flush out the line. We appreciate your continued support towards keeping Blowing Rock thriving!

Do not block any ditches or drains when putting out your items to be picked up. Yard debris (leaves, tree branches) will continue to be picked up on normal zone schedules (check the website or give us a call at 828-295-5200 if you are unsure of your zone). Do not block any ditches or drains when putting out your items to be picked up. We are **not** able to pick up propane tanks, electronics, roof shingles, tires or pallets.

There is no need to have your name put on a list - we'll pick items up all week!
