BACKGROUND: Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 160A-270(c), Town Council is authorized to sell personal property by electronic auction upon adoption of a resolution authorizing an appropriate town official to dispose of personal property belonging to the town by public auction. Resolution #2017-03 authorizes the Town Manager or his designee to sell the property via electronic auction on www.GovDeals.com.

Items to be sold include a 2006 Chevrolet Colorado (Public Works Department) and a 2000 Ford F-150 XL (Parks & Recreation Department). These vehicles have been removed from service due to their inability to pass NC State vehicle inspection.

We also request the disposal of thirty four (34) Fire Station overhead lighting fixtures. These fixtures are not able to be repurposed by the Town and therefore we would like to sell them via GovDeals auction.

GovDeals will be compensated at 7.5% of the total gross sale price for the sale through auction proceeds. The Town signed a contract with GovDeals.com on July 10, 2007 for disposal of surplus items utilizing the electronic auction method.

RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY & AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL (Resolution #2017-03)

Whereas, the Town of Blowing Rock has surplus property as listed below:

- 2006 Chevrolet Colorado- 79,931 miles- Fair Condition
- 2000 Ford F150 XL- mileage unknown, reader not functioning- Poor Condition
- 34 Overhead Light Fixtures- 15 small black metal 19 ¾" diameter & 19 large black metal 22 ½" diameter- Fair Condition

Whereas, North Carolina General Statute 160A-270(c) allows the Town Council to authorize an appropriate town official to dispose of personal property belonging to the town electronically by public auction.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Town Council of the Town of Blowing Rock declares surplus and authorizes the Town Manager or his designee to dispose of the above listed property via electronic auction on GovDeals - www.govdeals.com.

All sales will be processed through GovDeals and remitted to the Town net of auction fees. These items will be sold on an "as is" basis and all sales are final. The Town of Blowing Rock reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
