## Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Adopted Budget

Following budget work sessions and a public hearing, the Town of Blowing Rock Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget was adopted at the June 13, 2017 Town Council meeting. The Recommended and now adopted Budget is available on the Town's website www.townofblowingrocknc.gov.

The Fiscal Year 2017-2018 adopted budget totals \$14.52 million and includes \$8.0 million in the general fund, \$2.5 million for water and sewer operations, \$25 thousand for the BRAAC fund and \$4.0 million for capital projects. Included in the operating budget is debt service requirements for payment of principal and interest on borrowed funds such as lease-purchase payments and the general obligation bond. The FY2017-2018 Budget for debt service expenses, for both the General Fund and Water/Sewer Fund, total \$1.4 million or 13% of the total operating budget. The FY2016-2017 Adopted Budget for debt service expenses, for the General Fund and Water/Sewer Fund, totaled \$1.3 million or 15% of the total budget.

The adopted tax rate includes an increase of 3.0 cent, resulting in a tax rate of 37.0 cents per \$100, an increase of 9.0%. This increase will result in an additional annual tax amount owed of \$150 per year for a home valued at \$500,000, or \$30 annually for each \$100,000 of assessed taxable value.

To help ensure the system is able to recover its costs and not be subsidized by tax revenues when absorbing debt service costs associated with the water and sewer capital improvements planned, as well as current and a portion of future water/sewer fund associated general obligations debt service, a \$1.00 base-increase for both water and sewer along with a \$0.25 increase in the per thousand gallon rate for gallons consumed greater than 5,000 per two month billing period, are scheduled. These impacts are expected to increase a typical customer's bill by 4.0% beginning with July 2017 usage, billed in August 2017.

## New Meter Reading Technology to be installed in Blowing Rock:

### Public Welcome and Encouraged to Attend!

As part of its newly adopted budget for fiscal year 2017-2018, which begins on July 1, 2017, the Town of Blowing Rock has included a funding and implementation plan for a new meter reading, tracking and reporting program with Automatic Meter Infrastructure (AMI) technology that will offer water/sewer customers a number of benefits including a considerably higher degree of water consumption tracking and more timely leak detection capabilities. With a bi-monthly billing cycle, currently water/sewer customers are only able to detect a leak if it is to the degree that they notice an abundance of water on their property or in their home or when the next billing comes to them, which could mean the leak has been going on for up to two months. With the AMI technology (a meter head that would be installed on each account holder's meter), customers and Town staff will be able to track their daily water use and receive custom alerts when high usage is reported. The meter heads will cost \$260.00 each and the Town will be offering three payment options for the meter head. A customer may 1) purchase the meter outright via a one time payment of \$260.00. 2) make 6 bi-monthly payments over one year of \$44.28 bimonthly, or 3) make 12 bi-monthly payments over two years of \$22.14 bimonthly. Installation of the AMI meter heads throughout town is planned to begin in August 2017. There will be a full presentation of the technology at the regular July Town Council meeting to be held at Town Hall, 1036 Main St., Blowing Rock on Tuesday July 11th starting at 6:00 p.m. You are invited and encouraged to attend this meeting to learn more about the initiative. 


### Ditch Debris

Please remember when piling debris at the curbside not to block any ditches, culverts, drains or roadways. Blockage of this type can lead to flooding of your property or that of your neighbors. Anytime that you have yard debris it should be separated into three piles: limbs, plants, or loose leaves and should be piled out of the water drainage area.
