Sunset Drive Streetscape Revitalization To Begin Soon

It is exciting to note the Sunset Drive Streetscape project is beginning. Please find the proposed activity schedule below:

- Contractor Iron Mountain Construction
- Contract Amount \$2,327,932
- Contract Time 240 Calendar Days to Final Completion
- Contract Execution Through March 8
- Preconstruction Meeting Week of March 11
- Construction Start approximate week of March 25 Final Completion mid-November

Approximate Construction Sequence:



- 1. Water and Sewer Main St to Valley Blvd
- 2. Storm drainage small sections along the route
- 3. Sidewalks and Curb/Gutter Main St to Valley Blvd work
- 4. Paving Main St to Valley Blvd work
- 5. Landscaping

During Construction, one lane to remain open at all times. Both lanes open during non-working hours.

Summer Day Camp

Middle Fork Greenway Update

Substantial progress is underway for the Middle Fork Greenway, a 6.5-mile paved path connecting Blowing Rock to Boone, naturally. This project is directed under the leadership of Blue Ridge Conservancy, a local land trust dedicated to conserving Northwest North Carolina's natural resources and expanding recreational opportunities for its residents and visitors.

The Middle Fork Greenway has achieved great momentum with fundraising efforts and community support. In 2017 the Eastern Federal Lands Access Program (EFLAP) awarded \$1.8 million to the Town of Blowing Rock for construction of 1.2 miles of Greenway - from the trailhead near Shoppes on the Parkway through the Foley Center at Chestnut Ridge.

Blue Ridge Conservancy secured \$450,000 in required matching funds for the EFLAP grant from Blowing Rock Tourism Development Authority, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT), the State of North Carolina, Watauga County Tourism Development Authority, PeopleForBikes, the Dillon Family Foundation, private donors and local businesses that participated in the 2018 Round Up for the Greenway.

Withers Ravenel, an Asheville based engineering firm, was hired to develop the alignment, engineering plans and permits for this section. This work will be finished in the Fall of 2019, with construction to complete no later than year-end 2021.

Enthusiasm for this project has broadened beyond the towns' limits. In July of 2018, 111 local Watauga County businesses raised \$113,000 for the project during the month —long Round Up for the Greenway. These funds were used to leverage over \$1,000,000 in grant funding. With these funds in hand, BRC is preparing to construct the next 0.75 miles of greenway, including a pocket park, in 2019. This section will run from Tweetsie Railroad north to Niley Cook Road.

As NCDOT completes the Highway 321 widening project, the Middle Fork Greenway trailhead will be incorporated into the final plans. The trailhead will include a pavilion overlooking the headwaters of the Middle Fork New River, bike racks, an information kiosk, signage and landscaping. Charleston Forge is donating customized hand-forged benches for the trailhead. The pavilion is currently under construction, and opportunities for naming the pavilion are still available. Semi-Annual Water Line Flushing

The Town of Blowing Rock is planning the first of its two semi-annual "flushing" of the water lines to take place on **Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, May 7th, 8th,** and **9th, 2019.** This important preventive maintenance routine helps ensure our system customers have sustained levels of high water quality by removing sediment and deposits from the less used areas of the system. Some customers may briefly experience a temporary slight discoloration of water in the immediate vicinity of the flushing activity. If this happens in your area, please run your cold-water faucet to flush out the service line to your property. For rare but occasional extended discoloration, please contact Town Hall at (828) 295-5200 with your location and we will work to clear up any issues.
