

Holiday Recycling and Garbage Schedule

- Thanksgiving Holiday: Commercial garbage will be collected as usual.
- Christmas Holiday: Residential collection will not be affected. Commercial recycling will be collected on Tuesday, December 22. Commercial garbage will be collected on Wednesday, December 23. There will be no collection on Christmas Day.
- Residential recycling collection will not be impacted during either holiday.

For Successful Fall Leaf Pick-Up

Please do not place leaves in the road or ditch. Leaves will be picked up by the roadside with vacuum trucks for the next two months, weather permitting. Leaves need to be free of sticks and branches, and placed so they do

not block any drainage ways. When leaves become too wet to vacuum they need to be bagged and placed by the roadside for pick-up. We are once again using contracted labor to assist the Town staff in this process.
