## Plans to Construct a Larger Gazebo/Outdoor Performance Space in Memorial Park

The Town received generous offers of support from the Watauga Community Band (\$10,000) and the Blowing Rock Rotary Club (up to \$30,000) toward building a larger gazebo in Memorial Park to create a larger space for performances and community events of all kinds. At the April 8, 2014 Town Council meeting, Council voted unanimously to authorize staff to begin working with the two groups to discuss the appearance of the structure, costs and programming. Staff will return to Council with these details for the final approval of the project prior to construction.

## **Capital Planning Initiative**

The Town of Blowing Rock is working with the Town Engineers, McGill Associates, to conduct a survey to determine and itemize long term capital needs throughout the Town. The following categories will be part of the initiative: water distribution lines, sewer collection lines, water and sewer plants, ditch lines along Town streets, integrating utility and ditch work with the paving plan, streetscapes along Main Street and Sunset Drive, parks and recreation, and sidewalks and pedestrian connectivity. The study will help staff to determine funding needs for the upcoming and future budgets.

There is no need to call and have your name put on a list. The Bi-Annual Cleanup is offered in the spring and fall of each year.

## **Operation Safe Tree**



On March 31, 2014 the Town began removing 51 dead trees on the following Town properties: Davant Field, Broyhill Park, Memorial Park, Clark Street and Laurel Lane. The main

tree removal is now complete and cleanup has begun. To ensure Town properties retain their vibrancy, health, and beauty, the Town staff will be evaluating locations for new trees to be planted.
