Crime Prevention

Spring is the time when we all begin work on our yard and home improvement projects. Unfortunately, spring is also a time when home improvement scams begin to rise. Some criminals make their living driving through neighborhoods looking for people, especially the elderly, that they can make some quick cash on. Victims of home improvement scams usually report that a portion, or all of the work that they paid for was not completed or the quality of work was unsatisfactory. Once paid, these home improvement con artists usually can't be found. Simple tips such as the following, can help you avoid being scammed.

- 1. Only do business with reputable contractors or people that you know.
- 2. Never pay cash up front. Instead, offer to purchase the materials yourself.
- 3. Beware of people traveling through the area and those who claim to have materials left from another job.
- 4. Always get references.
- 5. Ask for the worker's identification and record the information.
- 6. Have a written agreement or estimate.
- 7. If you feel you are being scammed refuse to pay and call law enforcement.
- Never allow workers that you don't know to be unsupervised in your home, not even for a few minutes.

Project Updates



Memorial Park Improvements:

If you have visited Memorial Park recently you will notice a few changes. There are two new rock walls around the large Maple trees close to the gazebo. The walls were built by Jerry Shull Masonry. The project is sponsored by the Blowing Rock Appearance Advisory Commission with the support of the Parks and Recreation Department. The new walls will not only add to the aesthetics of the park but are also functional, by adding more space for visitors to sit and enjoy our beautiful village.



The Tennis Court fence replacement was completed by Statesville Fence.

Exterior improvements are underway as well at the Memorial Park Restroom Facilities. The improvements include gutter repair, painting and new roof installation.

All of these improvements are part of a larger initiative for renovations in the park.
