Planning and Zoning Updates

The Town Council recently approved two conditional use permits at their March 15th meeting:

- Up on the Hill Subdivision (CUP No. 2010-01) was approved to allow the creation of a 17-lot subdivision and a new public road. The 10.62 acre subject property lies between Goforth Road and Possum Hollow Road. Access will be provided from Goforth Road. The property will be annexed into the town for water and sewer service.
- CUP No. 2011-01 was approved for Six Pence Pub to demolish the former Sonny's Restaurant building and construct a patio for 32 outdoor dining seats. Demolition of the building is currently underway.

There are two other projects underway at this time as well.

- Phase II of the Downtown Streetscape Project is underway. Improvements include new storm drainage and curb and gutter in front of Town Hall along with concrete pavers installed in front of Memorial Park. Greene Construction of Boone was awarded this contract and NCDOT is participating in just over \$30,000 of the costs.
- M & M construction was recently awarded a bid for sewer line installation in the Wallingford St., Globe Ct., and Main St. area. This project will provide sewer for up to 12 additional customers.
